

# Iowa Amateur Softball Association (IASA) Men's 12-Inch Slow Pitch Hall of Fame Requirements

1. Individual photo of the nominee. 3 x 5 is the best size.
2. Recommendation deadline is July 1<sup>st</sup> in order for the nominee to be considered by the committee for election during the current calendar year.
3. In order to be approved for the induction into the Hall of Fame, an individual must receive a 60 % or greater majority of the votes as cast by the members of the selection committee.
4. Once an individual has been nominated, his name remains on the ballot for an unlimited period. However, after a 10-year period, it requires an 80% majority vote by the selection committee for the nominee to be elected.
5. There are no age or length of playing time requirements. However, both will be taken into consideration when reviewing a nominee for induction.
6. For a Player to be considered for induction, he must have played on an ASA state, regional, or national championship team in any of the following listed classifications:

Super, Major, Class A, Class B, Class C, Class D, Church, Industrial, Master, or Co-Ed

\* Any individual who is inducted into the National Hall of Fame will be automatically inducted into the Iowa Hall of Fame provided he meets the listed criteria. (With criteria #12 being the exception)

7. For an umpire to be considered for induction, he or she must have been an active ASA umpire for at least 10 years and have worked an ASA men's regional or national tournament. In addition, said umpire must have been retired for a minimum of 2 years.
8. For a sponsor to be considered for induction, he or she must have sponsored a men's ASA team in any classification for a minimum of 10 years. Special consideration will be given to those sponsors that have had teams compete in regional and national tournaments.
9. For a commissioner to be considered for induction, he or she must have been an active ASA commissioner for a minimum of 10 years.
10. For the category of meritorious service, the nominee must now be or have been a major contributor to the local or state slow pitch softball community as an organizer-builder, officer of a softball board, financial contributor, etc...
11. For a manager to be considered for induction, he or she must have managed an ASA men's team for at least 10 years and directed a team to a state, regional, or national championship title in any classification listed in item # 6 under player requirements.
12. All active players, sponsors, commissioner, or manager are eligible for induction into the Hall of Fame.
