ABOUT THE SCHOLARSHIPS

The Missouri A.S.A student scholarships are named in memory of long-time J.O. leader Gordon Johnson and Dan Kinney, Missouri's second State Commissioner. Mr. Johnson, of Savannah, served the Missouri A.S.A. for more than 30 years in numerous capacities including J.O. State Commissioner. Springfield Parks Director Dan Kinney was the Missouri A.S.A. State Commissioner from 1983 to 2002.

AWARDS NOMINATION GUIDELINES

The Missouri A.S.A. Board of Directors shall determine recipients for the Missouri A.S.A. Student Scholarships, according to the following guidelines. Nominations must be received in the Missouri A.S.A. State Office by September 15. Supporting documents must be included and are not returnable. Formal nominations will be accepted only through the Missouri A.S.A. State Office and acted upon by the Board of Directors. Award recipients will receive notification in December. Scholarship ceremonies are held during the Missouri A.S.A. Annual Convention in February.

MINIMUM REQUIREMENTS FOR CONSIDERATION:

STUDENT SCHOLARSHIPS

- Must be a high school senior *at the time of the application deadline.*
- Must have participated in the Missouri A.S.A. program during the past season.
- Demonstrated examples of citizenship, leadership and playing ability.
- Participation in non-A.S.A. programs will generally not be considered as part of the decision-making process, but may be included with the support materials.
- **Newspaper clippings must be photocopied to 8 ½ x 12 paper in order to be eligible for review.**

Nominations must be received in the State Office no later than September 15.
